# Kelly Sigler's 4 Day Level 3/4 Learning Journey

Focus on:

- Online- 45 ft. and long lines
- Liberty in round pen and larger areas
- Freestyle- beginning bridle less riding and find the finesse ingredients developed through freestyle riding
- Prep for Game of Contact and Finesse- basic lateral movements, 10 and 20 meter circles/ Precision Pen basics

Camp Highlights:

The camps are a four day intensive limited to 6 people, allowing for an optimal learning experience. Focus will be on the new levels program- in all four savvies.

You will have a 4 hour group lesson every day and a 45 minute private lesson. Each group lesson will focus on one of the savvies per day. Private lesson content will be driven by the needs of the student. Outside of scheduled class time, you will be able to play/ride on the playground and round pens as well as video your auditions. We can assist in videoing and



preparing the audition to send to Parelli. Every evening after dinner, we will meet to watch videos and video footage from the day - a great way to accelerate learning!

You will also go on a field trip during the week, either to Hitchcock Woods (one of the premier recreational riding destinations in the south) or a cross country course.

Both locations are a great place to play online and even do some videoing! There will be water elements, ditches, and all kinds of fun obstacles. We have just purchased the land next door so that we can include a precision pen, larger playground and jump field!



## Questions.... and Answers!

How much is tuition? \$685 with a \$100 deposit If you reserve a space before January 1. After January 1 the price is \$700, (\$100 deposit).

50% due 1 month prior to session and the remainder at start of session.

What do I get for my tuition?

In addition to the 4 hour group lesson and 45 minute private lesson every day, the following is included:

- ◆ Dinner at Orientation
- ◆ Lunch and Dinner for four days
- ◆ Complimentary beverages
- ◆ Stabling and 2 bags of shavings (others available for purchase)
- ◆ Facility Fees



What is not included?

- Accommodations. We have negotiated a very good rate at a B&B in Wagener. If you want info on that, call the Claridge House at: 803-564-8777.
- Fee for Cross Country Course (EST \$40) There is no additional fee for Hitchcock Woods.
- There is limited space for hookups. We can provide electricity and water for one hook up- but not a dump for grey/black water. Hookups \$15 per night additional.
- Horses. Bring your own! But Kelly will have George and Buckley available for you to work with if you cannot bring yours!

- Additional days: if you would like to come a day before or stay a day late, contact Kelly.
